

Shabbat Shalom Yisrael,

We pray that Everyone had a Blessed Pesach/Passover. Yahuah blessed us with a very tov Pesach Lamb, who was literally once again, the best of the flock:



We had a great Pesach on the evening of the 14th going into the 15th. We roasted the lamb over a fire, in the ***Kosher Roaster 2*** :-)) which was built by the Brothers here in Kansas, which worked perfectly and prevented the possibility of 'breaking any bones' when turning the lamb over while cooking.



After we ate the Pesach Meal, and all was done, we finally got everything burned up during the third watch of the night, as Scriptures Commands everything must be burned by morning.

Which brings us to today: Today is Aviv 21st, the Last Day of Unleavened Bread, which is also an annual Shabbat.

This evening, at the 9th 'sundial' hour of the day, Chag Matzoth/Feast of Unleavened Bread **Ends**. At that time, **from the 9th hour until sunset**, since Scripture gives us the allowance that we can cook today being the 21st, we can make **Leavened Bread** for the 22nd weekly Shabbat, which begins at sunset tonight.

We have this all in teachings, which we sent the links to last week, one of which is "**Are We Keeping 7 or 8 Days of Chag Matzoth/Feast of Unleavened Bread? & Scripturally What is Leavening?**"
