<p>The 6<sup>th</sup> day of every week is called preparation day, prepare enough food on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of every week for the 7<sup>th</sup> day Sabbath.</p>	<p>The 6<sup>th</sup> day is a preparation day for the Sabbath every week</p>	<p>Sabbath</p>	
<p>Ex. 12:16 And in the 15<sup>th</sup> first day of the first month (Abib) there shall be a Miqra Kodesh (<b>Holy Convocation</b>), and on the seventh day the 21<sup>st</sup> there shall be a Miqra Kodesh (<b>Holy convocation</b>) to you; no manner of work shall be done in them, except that which every man must eat, that only may be done by you.</p>	<p>Abib 15<sup>th</sup> First day Unleavened Bread A 'double' Sabbath</p>	<p>Abib 21<sup>st</sup> Annual Sabbath Day Last day Unleavened Bread</p>	<p>22<sup>nd</sup> A Sabbath</p>
<p>At the end of the month we prepare enough food on the 28<sup>th</sup> day for the 29<sup>th</sup> day or the last Sabbath. You can prepare food on Rosh Chodesh (new moon) .</p>	<p>28<sup>th</sup> day</p>	<p>29<sup>th</sup> Last Sabbath</p>	<p>New moon 1<sup>st</sup> day of month Prepare food on this day</p>
