Yahuah and had a testimony that he pleased Yahuah and was translated. Genesis 26:5. Abraham obeyed Yahuah voice, and kept His charge, His commandments, His statutes and His laws. Isaac and Jacob and his twelve sons knew the Sabbath day and keep Yahuah statutes.

In the Scriptures anything that sanctifies {Heb.gadhash} Yahuah persons, places, days and seasons belongs to Him. {Zondervan Dict. P751} Exodus 20:8-11 Remember the Sabbath Day to keep it Holy. Six days thou shalt labor and do all thou work; but the seventh day is the Sabbath of YHWH thou Elohim in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thou Son, nor thou Daughter, thy manservant, nor thou cattle, nor thy strangers that is within gates. For in six days YHWH made Heaven and Earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: Where forth YHWH blessed the Sabbath Day and hallowed it.

Isaiah 58:13 he calls the Seventh Day a **Holy** Sabbath [Heb.qadash].

Nehemiah 10:31 and 13:15-22 is one example to sanctify the Sabbath.

Exodus 34:21 six days thou shalt work, but on the seventh day thou shalt rest: in earing time in harvest thou shalt rest. We can see that Yahuah our Elohim created the Seventh Day as He rested on it, He also commanded us to do the same. Exodus 3:4-6 says where Moses stood was Holy ground because

because of Elohim presence. In Joshua 5:13-15 Yahuah told Joshua to loose the shoes from off his feet for the place where on he stood was Holy.

By Yahuah presence and by obeying His commandments we are sanctified and made Holy. Exodus 31:12-18 Yahuah said that the Sabbath was Holy and a sign [Heb. oth] between Him and His People that he doeth sanctify them. For the Sabbath is a perpetual covenant [continuing or enduring forever or indefinitely; continuing without interruption; continuous] Web. Dict. p 378 p 121.

In Exodus 16:1-30 Yahuah told Moses that He would rain bread from heaven six days. But on the sixth day there would be twice as much, as they gathered daily. In this way Yahuah proved them to see if they would walk in His laws or not, also He used the manna to teach the children about the Sabbath, because Yahuah had brought them out of years of bondage where they had toiled seven days a week, so now they knew the Sabbath.

If any bread was left until morning it brew worms and smell bad, on the sixth day they gathered twice as much. They lade up for the Sabbath and it remained good, this required two miracles from Yahuah, one to produce the manna, the other to preserve it on the sixth day to the Sabbath. The first day they gathered manna was the 16th of the month,

through the 21^{st.} The 15th and 22nd are Sabbaths, Six working days between them. They were keeping time by the sun and moon, in order to keep Yahuah Sabbaths.

Renewed Covenant N.T Matthew 5:17-19 Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfill. For verily I say unto you, till heaven and earth pass, one jot or tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.

Whosoever shall break one of these least Commandments, and shall teach men so, He shall be called the least in the Kingdom of Heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the Kingdom of Heaven.

Yahusha is telling us in these verses that the Law, Prophets and the Commandments are still in force. The Commandments have been removed from the Courts, Schools and other public offices, but we will be judge by the Word.

In Luke 4:16, Yahusha as His custom was He went into the Synagogue on the Sabbath Day to teach. He was observing the 4 Commandment, Remember the Sabbath Day to keep it Holy. Exodus 20:8-17

Mark 2:27-28 And He said unto them, "The Sabbath was made for man, and not man for the Sabbath. Therefore the Son of Man is Master also of the Sabbath". Yahusha the one that was speaking to them is the same one who created the Sabbath.

John 14:15 If you love me keep my Commandments. In this verse Yahusha is covering the First covenant (O. T) and the Renewed covenant (N.T).

John 14:21 He that hath my Commandment, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him. In this verse Yahusha is saying He will come to us as the Holy Spirit [Rauch HaKodesh] and manifest Himself to us, by teaching us His written word, his Commandment those in the First and also the Renewed Covenant.

1st John 2:3-5 And hereby we do know that we know Him, if we keep His Commandments. He that saith, I know Him, and keepth not His Commandments, is a liar and the truth is not in him. But whoso keepeth His word, in him verily is the love of YHWH perfected: hereby know we that we are in Him.

These words tell us if we say that we love YHWH, but we do not keep His Commandments we are liars. The Word is what will judge all of us at the Last Day. Matt. 12:36, 37 also John 12:47, 48. 1st. John 1:6, 7 If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth.
