


Torah/Law Teaching and Instruction

The word "<u>Law</u>" has been used to replace <u>**Torah**</u> 281 times by the translators in many Bibles

Are the <u>Torah/Laws</u> just for Israel? Are Christians to keep <u>Torah/Laws</u>?

Folk's I believe what Yahusha has shown us (the times of restitution of all things, what things? doctrinal truths Acts 3:20-24). This is the work we are doing is to teach obedience to the Commandments which is a life changing event, so much so it's from darkness unto light, or a better way is to state it is from death unto life! 1st John 1:5-6

Apostle Peter spoke by the leading of the Holy Spirit in the next verse, Act 3:23 And it shall come to pass, that every soul, which will not hear that prophet, shall be destroyed from among the people. Act 3:24 Yea, and all the prophets from Samuel and those that follow after, as many as have spoken, have likewise foretold of these days.

Apostle Peter states <u>every soul</u> that does not hear <u>that Prophet/meaning Yahusha</u> will be <u>destroyed</u> from among the people! Apostle Peter goes on to state that all of the Prophets from Samuel and those that followed after, have foretold of these days.

Mal 4:1 For, behold, the day cometh, that shall burn as an oven; and all the proud, yea, and all that do wickedly, shall be stubble: and the day that cometh shall burn them up, saith Yahuah of hosts, that it shall leave them neither root nor branch. (No decedents)

Mal 4:2 But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and <u>ye shall go forth</u>, and grow up as calves of the stall. (Children of the righteous) Mal 4:3 And ye shall <u>tread down the wicked</u>; for they shall <u>be ashes</u> under the soles of your feet in the day that I shall do this, saith Yahuah of hosts. (The children of the righteous shall tread down the ashes of the wicked under their feet, in the Millennial Kingdom)

There are billions of people worldwide that are facing eternity, are they ready? When we have the opportunity to ask people about doctrinal Truth, you will soon realize most are deceived. So if we can reach one person to instruct them that they are to keep the Torah/law, we are partaker with the body of believers in Messiah, in seeing a precious soul converted!!

As we continue, the word <u>Torah</u> means <u>teaching and Instruction</u>, in many Bibles the word <u>law</u> is used by the translators to replace the <u>word Torah</u>, this should not have been done; it has caused a great amount of <u>confusion</u> among brethren.

Folks without <u>teaching and instruction</u> how can we understand how to keep the <u>Moadim of Yahuah</u> beginning with the <u>Sabbath</u>, then the <u>Feast Days</u>, laws on marriage, and laws on how to avoid pagan worship etc, etc. The <u>law</u> instructs us what <u>clean animals</u> (The dietary laws) we may eat and what unclean animals not to eat; folks this law has not changed Lev. 11:1-47.

The word <u>Torah/Law</u> means <u>Teaching and Instruction</u>, in what? Answer, the Torah teaches us how to live and be <u>set apart from the world</u>, by an obedient life before Yahuah/Yahusha to be a <u>peculiar people a royal priesthood</u> Exodus 19:5-6, 1st Peter 2:9 Rev. 1:6. Folks when we break Torah/Law which everyone has, <u>when we repent</u> we have the High Priest Yahusha who intercedes for us, then we are forgiven, but we will be chasten. 1st John 1:6-10 Heb. 12:5-11

Brethren in the book of Luke 16:31 And he said unto him, If they <u>hear not Moses and the</u> <u>prophets</u>, neither will they be persuaded, though <u>one rose from the dead</u>.

Yahusha first tell people if they hear not Moses and the prophets, what is Yahusha saying? If people are not obedient to the First Covenant Moses and the Prophets (O.T). Then they will not hear my words, Yahusha said in the renewed Covenant (N.T).

Folks this is what Yahusha stated by Hs servant John in John 12:48 He that <u>rejecteth me, and</u> <u>receiveth not my words</u>, hath one that judgeth him: <u>the word that I have spoken</u>, the same shall judge him in <u>the last day</u>.

<u>The last day</u>, meaning at the first resurrection*, at the coming of Yahusha to judge His people, we will be judge by the laws written in the Word, which includes the <u>First Covenant (O.T)</u> and the <u>Renewed Covenant (N.T)</u>. * Mat. 24:29-31 first resurrection

Note: Yahusha spiritual body of believers is made up from many nationalities, but yet they are <u>one spiritual body</u>, therefore all believers are to keep the same Torah.

Folks this earth is a testing ground for you and me to learn <u>how to obey the Torah</u>, the Angels were tested and <u>one third followed satin</u>, Yahuah and Yahusha is testing all of His creation.

Brethren Apostle Paul writes many things hard to be understood; many teachers used this verse to teach against keeping the Torah. Romans 10:4 For Christ/Messiah is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone that believeth.

The <u>Law</u> that Apostle Paul was speaking about that <u>Yahusha fulfill</u> was "<u>The law of the animal Sacrifices</u>". Brethren Yahusha by His death, burial and resurrection <u>did not</u> do away with His Torah/Laws!

Folks remember there are 613 Commandments in the first covenant (O.T), the ones that <u>Yahusha fulfilled</u> was about His first coming, and by His death the laws of <u>animal sacrifices for sins is what ceased</u>, not His Torah/Laws.

All of the other commandments are still remaining; they instruct us how to live according to Yahuah Torah/laws. The 613 laws (O.T) also contain the 10 Commandments listed below from Exodus 19 and Deut 5; many of the Torah/Laws were for the Priests Hood. There are many other laws from (O.T) and (N T) that we will be judge by, there are over 1000 laws in the Renewed/Covenant (N.T).

Folks how can people be so blind to teach that the Law is laid aside, or that the Gentiles of our day are under Grace, and do not have to keep the Law. There is one law giver; Yahusha the Messiah and He gave the Torah for the first covenant and the renewed covenant. James 4:12 There is one lawgiver, who is able to save and to destroy: who art thou that judgest another?

A young man asked Yahusha in Mat 19:16 And, behold, one came and said unto him, Good Master, what good thing shall I do, that I may have eternal life?

Mat 19:17 And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, Elohim: but if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments.

What <u>Yahusha</u> told this young man has not changed, <u>"if you will enter into life,</u> we are to <u>keep His commandments"</u>, we have listed some of <u>Yahusha Commandments next</u>.

The Commandments are for All believers

Exodus 20:1-17 And Elohim spake all these words, saying,

Exo 20:2 I am Yahuah thy Elohim, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage.

Exo 20:3 Thou shalt have no other Elohim before me.

Exo 20:4 Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth:

Exo 20:5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I Yahuah thy Elohim am a jealous Elohim, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me;

Exo 20:6 And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.

Exo 20:7 Thou shalt not take the name of Yahuah thy Elohim in vain; for Yahuah will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.

Exo 20:8 Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.

Exo 20:9 Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work:

Exo 20:10 But the seventh day is the Sabbath of Yahuah thy Elohim: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates:

Exo 20:11 For in <u>six days Yahuah made heaven and earth</u>, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore <u>Yahuah blessed the Sabbath day</u>, and <u>hallowed it.</u>

- Exo 20:12 Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which Yahuah thy Elohim giveth thee.
- Exo 20:13 Thou shalt not kill.
- *Exo* 20:14 *Thou shalt not commit adultery.*
- *Exo* 20:15 *Thou shalt not steal.*
- *Exo* 20:16 *Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.*
- Exo 20:17 Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbors', These are Yahusha 10 commandments. In Hebrew they are called the "ten words" or "ten utterances".

Folks Yahusha death did not do away with His Commandments; this is only a small amount that we have just read". Folks many people keep Saturday or Sunday as the Sabbath using the roman colander, which is a man made calendar. The roman calendar was made to lead men away from keeping Yahuah Sabbaths. The roman calendar days such as christmas, easter, valentine day, etc, etc, these days are all pagan manmade days, this is used by the beast system to cause men to sin.

Folks if you do not study the first five books of Moses, you will not know what day the True Sabbath is on. Nor will you know that Yahuah's calendar is Solar Lunar, and is the only way to know what day Yahuah's Moadim are on. Yahusha made stronger <u>or</u> He strengthen His Torah/laws

Please read and think on what Yahusha stated in Matthew 5:28 listed below, we can see that Yahusha <u>strengthen His Torah/laws</u>. In the first Covenant <u>men/women</u> had to actually commit adultery, to be charged with adultery. As we have just read what is stated in Exodus 20:14 Thou shall not commit adultery.

Many people teach that the Torah/Law was done away with at the death of our Messiah, but we read in the renewed Covenant what our Messiah said. In Mat 5:28 But I say unto you, that whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.

We can see that <u>Yahusha strengthen His Laws</u>. Yahusha said <u>do not look to lust</u> after the opposite sex, and if you do you have already <u>committed adultery in your heart</u>. Folks Yahusha's laws are just as binding today as in the first Covenant (O.T). Men are stating that Yahusha laid His laws aside; these men are false witness, confusing most people causing them to <u>break</u> Yahuah Torah/Laws!!

Moses/Moshe said I have set before you life and death choose life that both you and your seed may live

Deuteronomy 30:19 I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both you and your seed may live:

In Deut. 30:1-20 Yahuah instructs Moses on what to tell the people, Moses said that Yahuah had set before them life and death, blessing and cursing, Moses said choose life, that both you and your seed may live.

Moses said to choose life, how do we chooses life? Next verse

Deu 30:20 That thou mayest <u>love Yahuah your Elohim</u>, and that thou mayest <u>obey his voice</u>, (His Commandments) and that thou mayest <u>cleave unto him</u>: for <u>He is thy life</u>, and the <u>length of thy days:</u> that thou mayest dwell in the land which Yahuah sware unto thy fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them.

Folks how do we <u>obey Yahuah voice? Answer</u>. When we read and obey His Scriptures, this is how we <u>obey His voice "His Commandments"</u>. Also the next verse from the Renewed Covenant our Messiah Yahusha speaking to us in, John 14:15 If ye love me, keep my commandments. Where are Yahusha Commandments located? Yahusha's Commandments are located in the <u>Torah/Law first covenant (O. T)</u>, ask yourself a question, then why do men teach that the Torah/Law is laid aside?

Remember we stated earlier that the <u>new test</u> has over a 1000 of Yahusha commandments in it, those we also must keep.

Brethren the Torah has not been done away with, we are to keep Yahusha Word/Scriptures, Commandments, folks this is for all people that has <u>chosen life</u>, and everyone is to keep the <u>same Torah/Laws</u>.

If we love Yahuah and His Son Yahusha we will keep <u>His Commandments</u>, in the <u>first Covenant</u> (O.T) and in the <u>renewed Covenant</u> (N.T)

Therefore to have life we are instructed to obey Yahuah Commandments, we have listed 13 verses as Scriptural witnesses that state "keep my commandments" next!

<u>Exo 16:28</u> And Yahuah said unto Moses, How long refuse ye to <u>keep my commandments</u> and <u>my laws?</u>

<u>Exo 20:6</u> And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.

<u>Lev 22:31</u> Therefore shall ye keep my commandments, and do them: I am Yahuah.

<u>Lev 26:3</u> If ye walk in my statutes, and keep my commandments, and do them;

<u>Deu 5:10</u> And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me and <u>keep my</u> <u>commandments.</u>

<u>1Ki 9:6</u> But if ye shall at all turn from following me, ye or your children, and will not keep my commandments and my statutes which I have set before you, but go and serve other gods, and worship them:

<u>2Ki 17:13</u> Yet Yahuah testified <u>against Israel</u>, and <u>against Judah</u>, by all the prophets, and by all the seers, saying, Turn ye from your evil ways, and <u>keep my commandments</u> and <u>my statutes</u>, according to all the law which I commanded your fathers, and which I sent to you by my servants the prophets.

<u>Neh 1:9</u> But if ye turn unto me, and <u>keep my commandments</u>, and do them; though there were of you cast out unto the uttermost part of the heaven, <u>yet will I gather them</u> from thence, and will bring them unto the place that I have chosen to set my name there.

<u>Pro 3:1</u> My son, forget not my law; but let thine heart keep my commandments:

<u>Pro 4:4</u> He taught me also, and said unto me, Let thine heart retain my words: <u>keep my</u> <u>commandments</u>, and live.

<u>Pro 7:2</u> <u>Keep my commandments</u>, and live; and my law as the apple of thine eye.

<u>Joh 14:15</u> If ye love me, keep my commandments. Where are Yahuah Commandments located? In the Torah the first Covenant, then why do men state that the Law/Torah is laid aside?

<u>Joh 15:10</u> If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love.

Folks Yahuah sent all of these <u>Prophets</u> to tell the people to <u>keep His commandments</u>. Folk's false teachers today have been blinded, by their <u>love of money more than the love for the</u> **TRUTH** of Yahusha.

Folks all <u>13 of these verses</u> we just read in the <u>Old and New Testament</u> are telling us to keep the <u>Commandments</u>. Yahuah changes not nor does His word change, for He is His Word.

Mal 3:6 For I am Yahuah, I change not; therefore ye sons of <u>Jacob/Israelites</u> are not consumed. Heb 13:8 Yahusha Messiah the same yesterday, and today, and forever.

Why would a perfect all mighty creator, have to change His Word as men are teaching? <u>He did not, He fulfilled His Word!</u> Mat 5:17 Think not that I am come to destroy <u>the law, or the prophets</u>: I am not come to destroy, <u>but to fulfill.</u>

Yahuah did not do away with His Torah/laws; His Commandments is what people will be judge by at the Judgment seat of the Messiah. Mat. 25:31-46 (At the first resurrection and first Judgment)

Most all people on the face of the earth have heard of <u>Abraham, Isaac and Jacob</u>, the fathers of the believers. In the next verse our messiah Yahusha makes this statement about <u>3 Patriarchs'</u> <u>Abraham, Isaac and Jacob</u>. Yahuah spoke to Abraham to <u>offer up his son Isaac for a burnt sacrifice</u>, this was a <u>test</u> of obedience for both Abraham and Isaac.

<u>Mat. 22:32</u> I am the Elohim of Abraham, and the Elohim of Isaac, and the Elohim of Jacob? <u>Elohim is not the Elohim of the dead, but of the living</u>.

Just as Abraham and his son Isaac was tried, people are being tried every day to know if they will keep Yahuah Commandments. Yahuah already know if we will serve Him or not, He wants us to know. When we become men and women of faith standing on the Scriptures, He wants us to be a witness for Him in the earth.

Please read what Yahusha said in the next verses to Martha, about her brother Lazars.

Joh 11:23 Yahusha saith unto her, Thy brother shall rise again.

Joh 11:24 Martha saith unto him, I know that he shall rise again in the <u>resurrection at the last</u> <u>day.</u> Martha knew when the first resurrection would take place, at the last day.

Joh 11:25 Yahusha said unto her, I am <u>the resurrection</u>, and <u>the life</u>: he that believeth in me, though he <u>were dead</u>, <u>yet shall he live</u>: At the first resurrection

Joh 11:26 And whosoever liveth and believeth in me <u>shall never die</u>. Believest thou this?

They that believe in Yahusha and <u>keeps His Laws shall not die</u>; this is speaking about the <u>second death</u>, they shall <u>not die the second death in the fire</u>. Yahusha is not speaking about the <u>first death</u> when man sinned, the <u>physical death</u> that He pronounced upon all of mankind in the beginning. Gen. 3:19

John 11:27 She saith unto him, Yea, Master: I believe that thou art the Christ/Messiah, the Son of Elohim, which should come into the world.

Folks Martha believed the Words of Yahusha; therefore I think she knew and believe <u>Moses and the prophets</u>*, this is how her faith increased, then she spoke to Yahusha, I believe that thou art the Christ/Messiah which should come into the world. * Martha listing to the Priest read Torah in the Synagogues on the Sabbath days; Martha believed the Messiah was coming.

How do you choose life as Moses stated? By keeping Yahuah's Commandments, many of them are in the first covenant (O.T), many more are in the renewed covenant (N.T)!!

All souls that die in the <u>faith</u> (Keeping His Commandments) are counted as alive, all though they are <u>physical dead and are asleep in the grave</u>, except those that were of "The Sheaf", these Yahusha took with Him after His resurrection. Mat. 27:52-53

We know Him if we keep His Commandments

Folks look at what is written in 1^{st} John 2:3 And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments.

John has made this point as clear as can be made, "And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments". This is very plain and to the point.

1st John 2:4 <u>He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments</u>, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.

If people say that they know Yahusha, and are not keeping His Commandments, they are lying, and the truth is not in them. Folks these last two verses are as plain as John can make them, if you are not keeping the commandments, then you do not know Yahuah or Yahusha or the Torah.

Now to answer the two questions we ask at the beginning

Are the <u>Torah/Laws</u> just for Israel? No, the Scriptures teach that <u>all believers</u> are to keep the Torah/Laws of Yahuah/Yahusha.

Are the <u>Torah/Laws</u> to be kept by Christians? Yes, as we have show in this short presentation, all believers are to keep the Torah/Laws of Yahuah/Yahusha.

Folks Yahuah did not give one set of Laws to Israel, and then give another set of laws for the souls converted after His crucifixion up until now. Some men call this the day of grace, other call it the church age.

<u>Acts 7:38</u> This is he, that was in <u>the church/Ecclesia in the wilderness</u> with the angel which spake to him in the mount Sina, and with our fathers: who received the <u>lively oracles</u> to give unto us:

The church (Ecclesia) actually began in the wilderness, when Yahusha gave the Torah/ lively oracles to Moses on Mount Sina, as the previous verse states. Exodus 20:1-17

Why do people state that from Yahusha death, burial and resurrection until now is the church age, or the time of grace? Their lack of bible study, and the love of money, or going along to get along have blinded the false teacher, they know not the TRUTH!

Look what Yahusha spoke through His <u>Prophet Isaiah</u> listed below from (O.T), and then what Yahusha had <u>Apostle Paul</u> to write from the (N.T). By the same revelation from the Spirit of Yahuah these <u>two Elohim fearing men</u> wrote the same point, next 2 verses.

<u>Isa 45:23</u> I have sworn by myself, the word is gone out of my mouth in righteousness, and shall not return, That unto me every knee shall bow, every tongue <u>shall swear</u>.

<u>Rom 14:11</u> For it is written, As I live, saith Yahuah, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to Elohim. Apostle Paul restated what was written in the first covenant

Question: If the Torah/Law was abolished by the death of our Messiah Yahusha, then what law will we be Judge by? Think about this folks

<u>Answer:</u> The Scriptures are stating that people in <u>the first covenant</u> (O.T) and people in the <u>renewed covenant</u> (N.T) will be judge by the same Torah/Law. Therefore all believers in Yahuah and in Yahusha are commanded to keep the Commandments, the Torah/Laws.

There are major event occurring all over the world at the <u>same time</u>, these are the signs of the coming of Yahusha, <u>Praise Yahuah</u>, <u>Praise Yahusha</u>.

Mark 13:37 And what I say unto you I say unto all, Watch.
